Leading Pedagogical Learning

It has been great to work with schools in the Leading Pedagogical Learning program in developing their Pedagogical Frameworks (High Yield Teaching Strategies, Lesson Series or Lesson Structure). All the Pedagogical Frameworks have had Teach Like a Champion techniques embedded through double planned documents and have created clear action steps for each element of the Pedagogical model.

Coaching Pedagogy

We are excited that from our Leading Pedagogical Learning workshop we have develop the Pedagogical Coaching program aligned to the "Get Better Faster" resource written by Paul Bambrick-Santoyo which is aligned to coaching teachers on implementing Teach Like a Champion. This program will build on existing teaching, leadership, and coaching skills through the Principles of Coaching – **INTENT** Granular Teaching Goals / techniques, **LEARN** Plan, Practice, Follow Up (See it, Name it, Do It Model) and **FEEDBACK** Praise, Probe and Plan.

Teach Like a Champion - Check for Understanding - Feedback Codes

Standardise the Format focuses on streamlining data-gathering and making your observations more efficient and accurate. In the video link below Ijeoma gives her students written feedback using a code. This give students feedback instantly and can also be used for anecdotal records.

D = Distribution Error

C = Calculation Error

I = Incorrect Exponent Rule

S = Set up (Check the operation or order of terms)

Cold Call – Culture

At the Engaging Academics workshop with Doug Lemov we looked at making sure we have a Cold Call Culture. Please see the framework below:

Preparation	Invitation & Appreciation	Formative Language	Peer validation
Give students time to think & ready their answers	Tell them that you've chosen them to honour their thinking	"Get us started" tells students answers should be useful not perfect & cues classmates to listen	Knowing that their peers valued their ideas motivates future participation
Turn and Talk Everybody Writes EW T & T Transparent Wait Time	"Molly, I like what you wrote about x"	"can you get us started talking about"	"Who can build on Molly's idea?"
